Maipo Valley, Chile

## The wine

Lively aromas of red currant and dried cherry intertwine with vanilla and sweet spices. A smooth silky texture and fine tannins add balance, providing a beautiful and lingering finish.

Aging: 12 months in French oak, 25% new

Alcohol: 14.5%
